Ferðin er farin til að taka þátt í hinni árlegu ráðstefnu, *City Lab*, sem nú er haldin í fimmta sinn undir forystu Michaels R. Bloomberg fyrrum borgarstjóra New York og er haldið af tím aritinu *The Atlantic* í samvinnu við *The Aspen Institute* og *Bloomberg Philanthropies*. Yfirskrift ráðstefnunnar er *Urban Solutions to Global Challenges* og er yfirlýstur tilgangur hennar að stefna skapandi borgarstjórum og öðrum gerendum í borgarmálum saman við listamenn, fræðafólk, fjárfesta og aðra leiðtoga í opinberum og einkageirum - með áherslu á framþróun borga og útbreiðslu árangursríkra þéttbýlisáætlana. Borgarstjóra barst boð á rástefnuna í lok ágúst frá Michael R. Bloomberg fyrrum borgarstjóra New York og stofnanda góðgerðarsamtakanna *Bloomberg Philanthropies* en í dagskrá borgarstjóra á ráðstefnunni er sérstök áhersla á svokallaða nýsköpunarvinnustofu borgarstjóra (e. Mayors Innovation Studio) sem fram fer sunnudaginn 22. október. On Monday and Tuesday, mayors will be joined by some of the most innovative leaders focused on improving global cities in plenary and breakout sessions, networking opportunities, and guided field trips. All content is aimed at equipping attending mayors with new ideas they can bring back and apply to local challenges.

The cost of travel, lodging, and most meals while attending CityLab will be covered by the Aspen Institute.
