



Borgarráð

Þátttaka Reykjavíkurborgar í verkefninu Planet Youth

Lagt er til að borgarráð samþykki drög að samstarfssamningi Reykjavíkurborgar og ICSRA (Icelandic Centre for Social Research and Analysis) vegna verkefnisins Planet Youth.

Greinargerð:

Viðauki vegna verkefnisins Planet Youth var lagður fram í borgarstjórn þann 5. desember sl. þar sem samþykkt var í fjárhagsáætlun að fjárheimildir miðlægrar stjórnarsýslu yrðu hækkaðar um 10 mkr. vegna umrædds verkefnis. Verkefnið er til þriggja ára, 2018 til 2020 en greiðslur eru áætlaðar tvisvar á ári, þann 1. janúar og 1. júní ár hvert, með fyrstu greiðslu þann 1. janúar 2018. Samstarfið snýst m.a. um að tryggja fagmennsku þegar kemur að fræðslu og aðgerðum vegna vímuefnavanda barna og ungs fólks, með því að kynna aðferðafræði Planet Youth sem grunn að stefnu og framkvæmd í slíkum málefnum. Síðustu tvo áratugi hefur Reykjavík verið leiðandi borg í forvörnum hvað varðar vímuefnanotkun unglinga en áhugi er á því að dreifa slíkri þekkingu til annara borga og sveitarfélaga í heiminum en margar evrópskar borgir vinna nú að forvörnum að íslenski fyrirmynd. Þá er gríðarlegur alþjóðlegur áhugi fyrir verkefninu sem sést m.a. á nýlegri umfjöllun BBC um málið. Meðfylgjandi er hlekkur á frétt BBC frá 15. nóvember sl.:

Planet Youth - Evidence Based Primary Prevention

Partnership Agreement between Reykjavik City and ICSRA (Icelandic
Centre for Social Research and Analysis).



Aim: To ensure professionalism in primary substance use prevention amongst children and youth worldwide by introducing the Planet Youth methodology as a basis for policy and practice.

Preface: Cities and municipalities all over the world look towards Iceland because of the success in reducing adolescent's substance use for the past two decades.

Ever more cities realize the importance of reducing adolescent's substance use and that it needs to be a collaborative cross border and cross continent effort. The City of Reykjavik has been the leading capital in primary prevention and wishes to distribute knowledge and influence other cities and municipalities towards the same worldwide.

The parties to the Partnership Agreement decide on the following:

Clause #1- ICSRA commitments

1. ICSRA promotes the methodology of the Icelandic Prevention Model and the work of the City of Reykjavik towards improving the lives and living conditions of youth through the Planet Youth network of cities and municipalities worldwide.
2. ICSRA coordinates and leads bi-annual youth research, based on the Icelandic Prevention Model and the work in cities and municipalities who wish to adapt the model.
3. ICSRA provides local researchers in the participating cities with all research material, methodology and information to ensure coordinated research procedures between the cities, including, but not limited to: standardized field procedures for data collection, standardized data entry forms and list of concepts and measures for researchers future data use.
4. ICSRA analyzes all data emphasizing risk and protective factors towards and against early substance use and produces descriptive reports for local authorities, policymakers and people working directly towards reducing adolescents substance use in the participating cities.
5. ICSRA introduces research findings in each participating city through lectures and seminars for politicians, field workers and practitioners.
6. ICSRA attends meetings, conferences and seminars arranged by local authorities in cooperation in order to make prevention workers capable of using research findings to promote preventive measures to social bodies and families.
7. ICSRA encourages authorities to distribute findings to NGO's and other organizations working with substance abuse prevention amongst youth.
8. ICSRA promotes the City of Reykjavik as the World Capital of Prevention in all lectures and during all events associated with this partnership, worldwide.
9. ICSRA introductory slides all include the Reykjavik City official logo.
10. ICSRA seeks all ways to promote Reykjavik City and attract professionals in the field of prevention to visit the city during lectures, workshops and seminars arranged by ICSRA.

Clause #2- Reykjavik City commitments

1. Reykjavik City supports ICSRA towards distributing knowledge about the Icelandic Prevention Model through the Planet Youth network, worldwide, by contributing a grant of ISK 10.000.000,- (ISK Ten million) to ICSRA for a period of three years, 2018, 2019 and 2020. The Reykjavik City contribution supports ICSRA to maintain and strengthen the network of cities, either directly participating in the Planet Youth Program and/or adapting the Icelandic Prevention Model to their local conditions. The grant is paid in two separate payments annually, 1st of January and 1st of June each year, first 1st of January 2018.
2. Reykjavik City appoints a contact person as a member of a joint consulting committee for Planet Youth.

Clause #3 - Validity of agreement

The contract is valid from date of signature until 31st of December 2020.
