Eins mun borgarstjóri taka þátt í málstofunni *Reinventing Cities*, miðvikudaginn 22. maí milli kl. 16.00 til 18.00, en málstofan, sem haldin er af C40 og Climate-KIC, er helguð þeim verkefnum sem hafa orðið hlutskörpust í hugmyndasamkeppni í 15 borgum víðs vegar um heim þróun sjálfbærrar borgaruppbyggingar á vannýttum svæðum. Með borgarstjóra og oddvitum í för verða Pétur Krogh Ólafsson aðstoðarmaður borgarstjóra og Hilmar Hildar Magnússon alþjóðafulltrúi. Hjálagt er boðsbréf og dagskrá ráðstefnunnar.

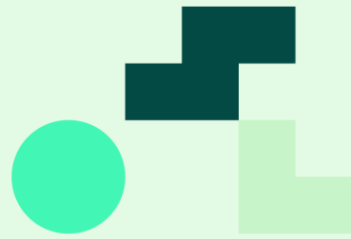
