Fyrirhuguð er þátttaka borgarstjóra og oddvita borgarstjórnarflokka í Norrænu höfuðborgaráðstefnunni sem haldin er annað hvort ár og fer að þessu sinni fram í Osló í Noregi briðjudaginn 21. maí 2019. Eins mun borgarstjóri taka þátt í málstofunni Reinventing Cities, miðvikudaginn 22. maí milli kl. 16.00 til 18.00, en málstofan, sem haldin er af C40 og Climate-KIC, er helguð þeim verkefnum sem hafa orðið hlutskörpust í hugmyndasamkeppni í 15 borgum víðs vegar um heim þróun sjálfbærrar borgaruppbyggingar á vannýttum svæðum.
