**Þar sem þetta er EES útbóð, hvar er hægt að nálgast úboðsgögn á ensku? Verklýsingu og tilboðsskrá.**

**Svar 1:**

**Útbodsgögn verða ekki á ensku en hér að neðan er almenn lýsing á útboðinu á ensku:**

**The procurement office of the city of Reykjavík requests participants in a framework agreement regarding control equipment for traffic lights, i.e. traffic light control boxes, sensors, lamps and push button boxes for the city of Reykjavík, according to further explanations in tender documents.**

**Offer should entail everything that is included with the product as it is defined in these tender documents. Offer should be made on the enclosed tender sheet. This refers to a framework agreement that is based on regulations surrounding public procurement no. 120/2016. The agreement is valid for four years from its signature date. The agreement may be terminated pending a three month term of notice.**

**The quantity of bought product based on these tenderings are not yet clear, since the framework agreement will be made for particular products or services for a disclosed amount of time, without knowing the exact quantity of products needed. The framework agreement does not include a promise to invest in any definite amount of products. During the last 12 months, the city of Reykjavík has invested in approx. 8 traffic signal controllers (in cabinets) with 40 sensors, 40 signal heads and 40 push button boxes. It is estimated that during the contract period approx. 50 traffic signal controllers with 250 sensors, 1.000 signal heads and 550–600 push button boxes will be replaced.**

**Procurements through this agreement are almost exclusively meant to replace traffic lights that are not connected to a centralized control computer and those traffic lights that need to be completely replaced due to their expiration date. Any procurements that are made due to maintenance of older appliances of the city of Reykjavík or to uphold any terms of guarantee made by the vendors of the older equipment are exempt from this agreement. This also applies to any products that are bought to fulfil any specialized needs for the city of Reykjavík for up to 10% of the agreement's turnover.**
